

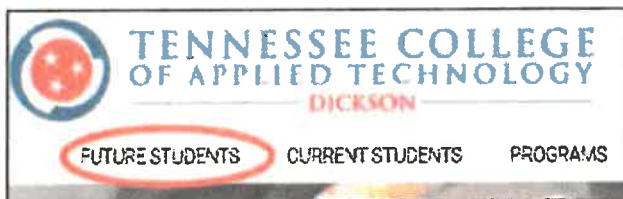


APPLYING FOR THE TSAC DUAL ENROLLMENT GRANT

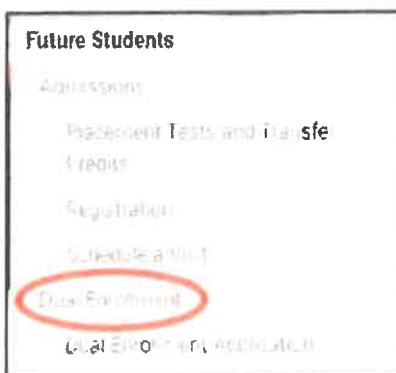
Dual-enrolled high school students must take the following steps to apply for the Dual Enrollment Grant with the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation (TSAC) and be eligible for the grant to fund tuition at the TN College of Applied Technology – Dickson & Clarksville campuses. Failure to complete this application will result in dual-enrolled students being responsible for their own tuition expenses by paying out-of-pocket.

STEPS:

1. Go to <https://tcatdickson.edu/>.
2. Click on "Future Students":



3. Click on "Dual Enrollment":



NOTE: Do not click on Dual Enrollment Application – this application is not the TSAC application you need to locate

4. Scroll down to "Process" and select #2:



5. You are at the TSAC Student Portal Now!



6. You will need this information handy...

- Student's First Name and Last Name - as it appears on the Social Security card
- Student's Social Security Number - as it appears on the Social Security card
- Student's Date of Birth
- Student's email address (if available)

7. Register as a first time user



8. Enter Create a Login if you are a First Time applicant

Dual Enrollment Grant
 The Dual Enrollment Grant is a scholarship offered to high school juniors and seniors who are enrolled at an eligible high school and who are in pursuit of college credit while dual enrolled at an eligible postsecondary institution. To be eligible, a student must have completed all sophomore academic requirements, complete and submit the Dual Enrollment Grant application by the application deadline date for each semester, be a TN resident for one (1) year, meet admission criteria for dual enrollment.

A student may receive funding for up to 4 courses per semester. To receive funding for one additional course per semester, the student must meet the minimum HOPE Scholarship academic requirements.

A student who receives the Dual Enrollment Grant for more than four (4) dual enrollment courses over the course of the junior and senior years will have the amount reduced from the HOPE Scholarship on a dollar for dollar basis.

To proceed, select the scholarship in which you are pursuing.

Additional Courses Acknowledgement**

This statement serves as an acknowledgement that upon receiving an award offered under the Tennessee Dual Enrollment Grant Program, funded from the Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship Program, this award does not guarantee acceptance into any institution of higher education or receipt of a HOPE Scholarship.

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §49-4-930, I understand that if I enroll in more than four (4) Dual Enrollment Grant courses then funds used for the additional courses will be deducted on a dollar for dollar basis from my HOPE Scholarship award. I further understand that this deduction shall be applied in full against the amount of my HOPE Scholarship award in my first semester. If my HOPE Scholarship award in the first semester is less than the amount of the total deduction, the remaining deduction amount will be applied against my second semester HOPE Scholarship award, and subsequent semesters if necessary, until the deduction is eliminated.

I also acknowledge that college courses taken under the Dual Enrollment Grant Program do not count towards the attempted hours and continuation requirements of the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship once I am enrolled in an eligible postsecondary institution.

Definition: Dual Enrollment Grant

The Dual Enrollment Grant program is defined as a grant for study at an eligible postsecondary institution that is funded from net proceeds of the state lottery and awarded to students who are attending high school and who are also enrolled in college courses at eligible postsecondary institutions for which they will receive college credit.

General Requirements and Instructions:

The Dual Enrollment Grant provides financial assistance to qualified high school students in pursuit of postsecondary study at an eligible Tennessee public or private institution while receiving college credit.

The application must be completed and processed by the deadline date each semester in order for a student to participate and receive funding from this grant. The processing deadline dates for colleges are: September 15 for fall enrollment, February 1 for spring and May 15 for summer enrollment. The processing deadline dates for Tennessee Technology Centers are: November 1 for fall enrollment, March 1 for spring and May 15 for summer enrollment.

To participate in the Dual Enrollment Grant program, a Tennessee high school Junior or Senior must be a Tennessee citizen and resident of the state for one (1) year prior to enrollment and enrolled in postsecondary courses leading towards a degree. For continued participation, a student must maintain a 2.75 cumulative college grade point average that shall be certified by an Enrollment Services representative each semester. Once the courses and minimum cumulative grade point average are certified, a representative of the Bureau's Office shall process the award. College courses taken under the restrictions of this grant do not count towards the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship eligibility requirements and continuation requirements.

Students eligible to participate in the Dual Enrollment Grant program may enroll in courses paid at the rate of \$100 per postsecondary semester/term credit hour or approved Tennessee Technology Center schedule. Students who receive the Dual Enrollment Grant amount for more than four (4) dual enrolled courses over the junior and senior years will have the amount reduced from their HOPE Scholarship on a dollar for dollar basis.

Students who enroll in one (1) additional course per semester must meet the HOPE Scholarship eligibility requirements at the time of enrollment as a dual enrolled student. This grant is subject to the availability of funding and shall only be applied towards college tuition. Other discount vouchers received by the student shall be applied toward the cost of tuition prior to utilizing the Dual Enrollment Grant. Other postsecondary institution costs not covered by this grant are the responsibility of the student.

The student shall contact the Admissions Office of the selected eligible postsecondary college to apply for admission and be accepted as a dual enrollment student. The student applying for the Dual Enrollment Grant program must be certified as eligible by the postsecondary institution and gain admission as a dual enrollment student and be enrolled in high school.
