The Equipment Mechanic is responsible for inspecting, diagnosing, and performing preventative maintenance and repairs including overhauls, rebuilds, replacement of components, and system installation on a mixed fleet of vehicles. Other responsibilities include performing preventive maintenance checks and repairs on airport vehicles and equipment, including oil changes, brake repairs, and tire changes and repairing mechanical, hydraulic, and electrical systems.

Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Operates and repairs a variety of machinery, including fire trucks, construction equipment, farm tractors, and a general-purpose fleet.
- Inspects, diagnoses, and performs preventative maintenance and repairs.
- Conducts repairs to mechanical, hydraulic, and electrical systems; such as overhauls, rebuilds, replacement of components, and installs new systems when necessary.
- Diagnoses and repairs all emergency vehicles such as police vehicles and fire trucks in various locations, including on the airfield.
- Performs preventive maintenance checks and repairs on airport vehicles and equipment, including oil changes, brake repairs, and tire changes.
- Coordinates with vendors, including gathering information for ordering parts, correcting parts orders when incorrect parts are received, performing price matching, and resolving paperwork discrepancies.

Qualifications:

Required: High School Diploma or equivalent. 2 to 4 years of automotive repair, heavy equipment repair, or related experience.

Preferred: Associate's Degree or certificate in automotive technology, or equivalent military training. 4 to 7 years of automotive repair, heavy equipment repair, firefighting equipment maintenance, or related experience.
