Industrial Maintenance Mechanic Job Purpose: Maintains production and quality by ensuring operation of machinery and mechanical equipment.

Industrial Maintenance Mechanic Job Duties:

- Controls downtime by being able to troubleshoot and fix equipment in a timely manner.
- Fabricates repair as needed able to weld and follow instructions to maintain tooling thru-out plant.
- Conserves maintenance resources by using equipment and supplies as needed to accomplish job results.
- Provides mechanical maintenance information by filling out preventive maintenance work order assignments sheets in a timely manner.
- Maintains continuity among teams by documenting and communicating actions, irregularities, and continuing needs.
- Maintains safe working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations such as lock out tag out.
- Maintains clean environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations such as housekeeping
- Contributes knowledge to team and able to get along with others.
- Able to learn to start and shutdown all equipment thru-out plant.
