The Airport Communications Technician is responsible for performing airport surveillance, monitoring access, and receiving calls in the Airport Communications Center (ACC).

Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Dispatches personnel to investigate complaints, security infractions, and reported emergency and medical situations.
- Dispatches ARFF emergency units to an accident scene or aircraft emergencies and saves video footage as required.
- Uses electronic equipment including the National Crime Information Center (NCIC).
- Monitors all radio traffic.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Some college in a related field required.
- One (1) to three (3) years of call taking, law enforcement, dispatching, or related experience required.
