- Capable of performing advanced diagnostics and repairs on all equipment systems to include: hydraulic, pneumatic, mechanical, electrical, pipefitting and welding. (see individual Skills Training Matrix for updates)
- Must be able to look up parts from equipment drawings, schematics and parts lists. Must be able to fill out parts requisitions in order to purchase.
- Each individual must be able to understand (after training) our Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) and be able to conform to our work order procedures.
- Must be able to perform job responsibilities and duties with little or no supervision.
- Must be able and willing to train others in the performance of their job responsibilities and duties.
- Must be capable of doing job layout and new installation projects.
- Must be able to work off of a ladder, scissor lift or boom with no height limitations.
- Must be able to read, write and do basic mathematics.
- Must have own tool box complete with tools. (See requirement list of tools needed for the job)
- Able to bend, stoop, grip, reach and lift up to 40 pounds on a repetitive basis.
- Must be able to stand for the majority of any shift 8hr or 12hr.
- Steel toe shoes/boots are required to work in the Maintenance Department.

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
