Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Works collaboratively with internal departments and business partners to provide resolutions to day-to-day tenant or airport user issues.
- Conducts airport leaseholds and facilities inspections to ensure compliance with lease terms and conditions and established Nashville International Airport practices.
- Identifies and monitors compliance issues as they relate to public and passenger safety.
- Monitors and follows up for compliance on all agreements, leases, permit terms, and conditions.
- Prepares correspondence, documentation, exhibits, and tenant reports.
- Maintains accurate records of all lease and concession agreements, including effective dates, termination dates, and type of concession operation.
- Prepares a variety of leases, amendments, permits, and other legal documents for manager review.
- Resolves day-to-day tenant issues routinely with manager oversight.
- Gathers, analyzes and processes data to create summaries and conclusions for concessions and/or property-related issues.
- Initiates and cultivates communication with airport tenants, other airport users, and business partners to ensure favorable working relationships among departmental administration, tenants, and community.
- Responds to general requests regarding airport concessions, business partners, and/or properties.
- Shows available property or space to prospective tenants.

- Bachelor's Degree in business administration, aviation, airport management, or equivalent education or experience in a related field required.
- 1 to 3 years of lease agreements, compliance, or related experience required.
